Nigel will talk about how he manages what is now a \$50m turnover business, including comments about the new AFL Womens league and how the Adelaide Football Club manages its leadership and high performance culture and building strong relationships with key industry stakeholders to achieve commercial growth.

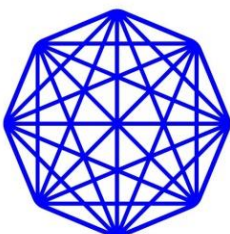
